

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The **West Alabama Health Services, Inc. (West Alabama Public Transportation)** is applying to the Alabama Department of Transportation for Operational, Administration, Planning and Capital assistance award under 49 U.S.C. Section 5311 of the Federal Transit Laws, and funding under the Section 5311 (F) -Intercity Program. This Grant funding will provide financial assistance for public transportation service for the residents of **HALE COUNTY**.

The service is provided for general public and currently operates Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 9 p.m., Saturday and Sunday Upon Demand. All residents, including mobility device users must schedule service 24 hours in advance. Fares are \$ 2.00 per one-way trip (intercity) other locations fare varies depending on trip location. No services or fares changes are planned for **FY2027**.

The grant funding will provide federal financial assistance for Administration, Operational, Planning and Capital Expenses. Capital funding will be used to purchase (2) two (9) nine passengers' vehicles with (1) one mobility device securements.
